

In-Person Survey Interviewer

Summary: Seeking an outgoing, personable individual to administer bilingual survey questions (Spanish & English) in-person at designated sites across eastern Ulster County using a tablet. Surveys are being used to understand the needs of users and non-users of outdoor recreational areas. You are responsible for transporting yourself to and from the sites during the agreed upon dates/hours. In some cases, there may be someone to greet you, but in some cases there will not. You should be comfortable approaching diverse strangers and initiating conversations in a friendly manner. Bias training will be provided. All surveying will take place in public locations during daytime hours. You will check in via text message at the beginning and end of each shift.

This is a temporary contractual (1099) position that pays \$24 per hour for up to a maximum of 40 hours within the given date range. Payment will be administered in two parts: \$480 after the first 20 hours are complete and \$480 after the remaining 20 hours are complete. The commute to and from survey sites is not included in hours worked; compensation for mileage is factored into the hourly rate. College credit offered.

Timeline: July 18th-August 26th

Dates/Hours: TBD; we will work with you to create a schedule, but you can expect 8-10 dates that fall over weekdays and weekends, for 3-4 hours per day; morning/midday/afternoon time slots.

Locations: Various sites in eastern Ulster County including the regions of Shawangunk, Gardiner, New Paltz, Rosendale, Esopus, Lloyd, Highland, Kingston, Plattekill, and Marlborough

Requirements:

- Reliable transportation
- Fluent in English and Spanish
- Some weekend hours required
- Comfortable using tablets/technology
- Believes the outdoors should be welcoming and equitable for all humans
- Independently motivated; does not require micromanaging

Employer Responsibilities:

- Ensure you are trained in the software/hardware
- Provide overview of techniques to minimize survey bias
- Support via Zoom/phone while you are in the field if there are questions/problems
- If desired, provide support for college credit
